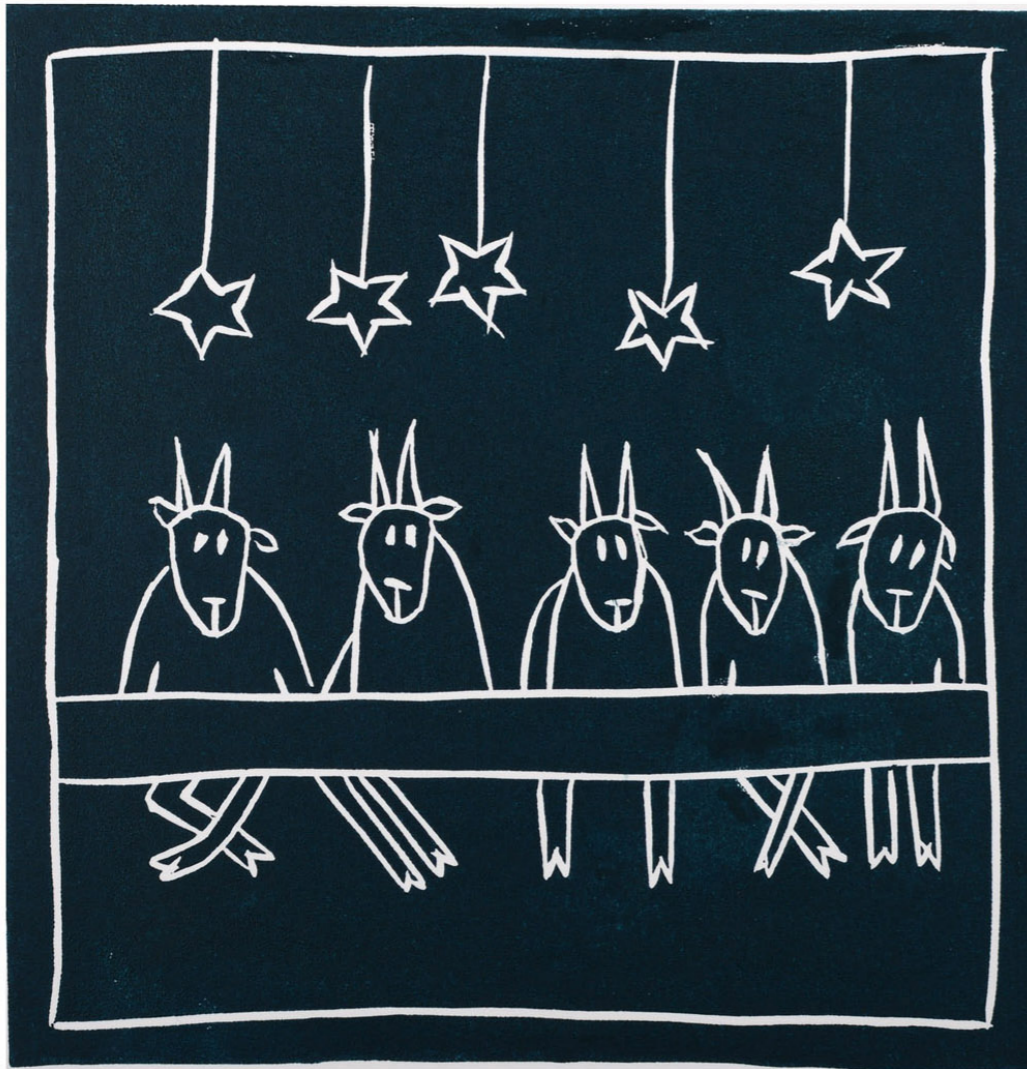




The lives of gazelles

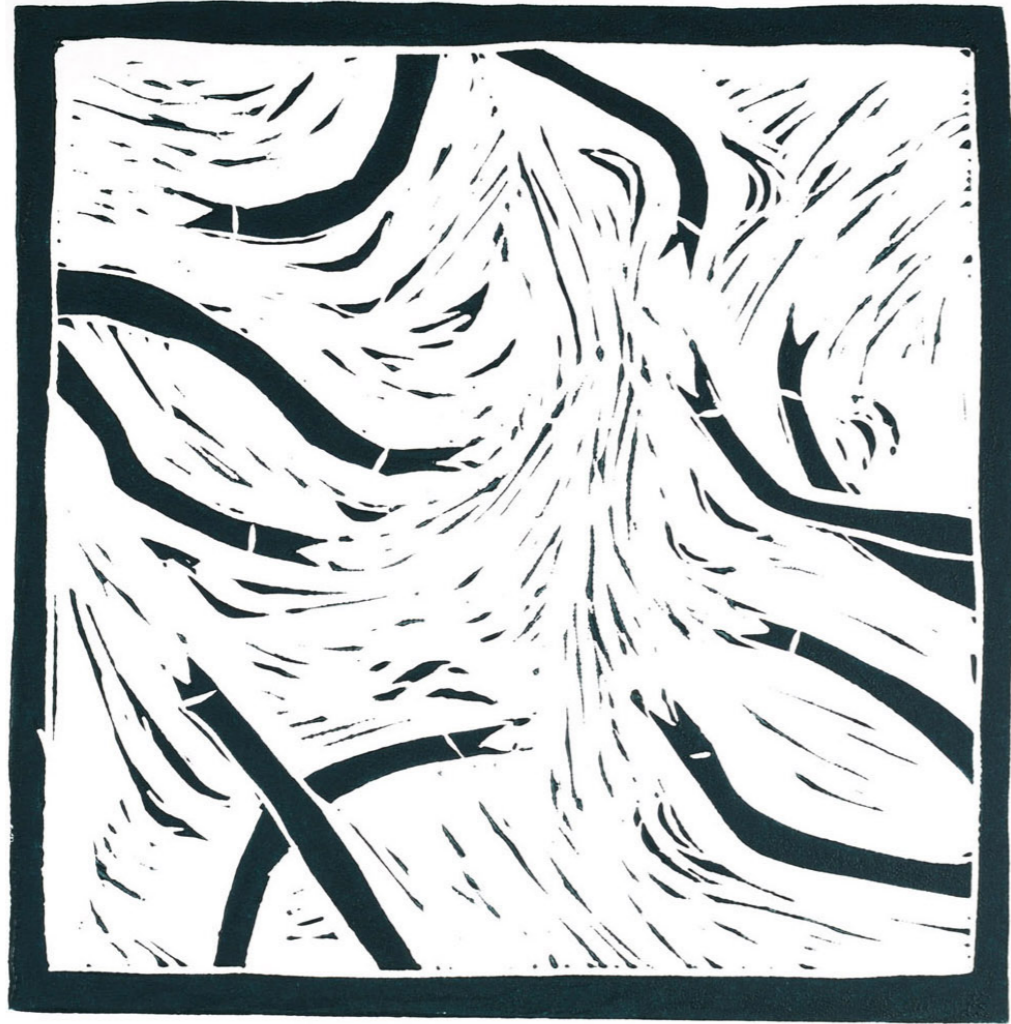

Some smart animals gave gazelles the job to look after watercress fields. Good idea? No! They returned to find no watercress left. The gazelles were gone.





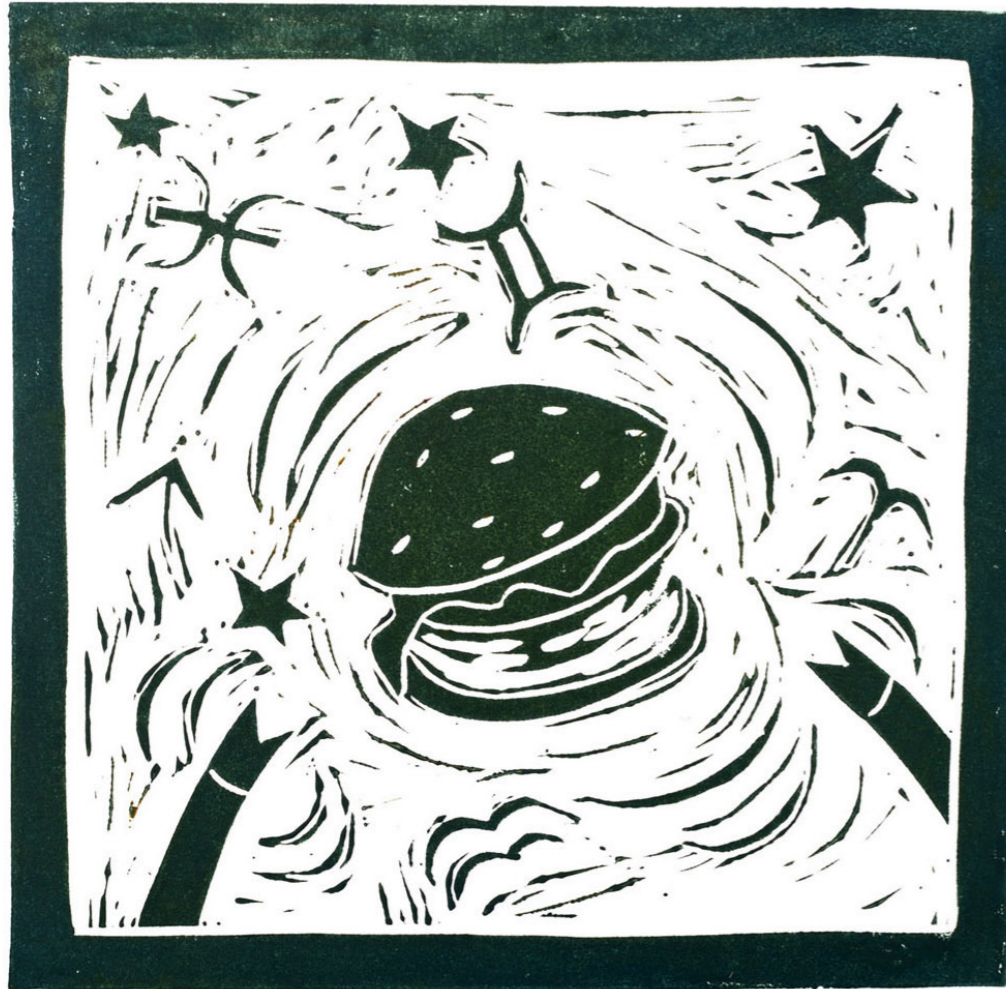
Gazelles are taken to court for stealing tins.

Gazelle goes to McDonald's and buys a Big Mac. She turns it into vegetarian matter with the power of prayer (she had acquired an online certificate).

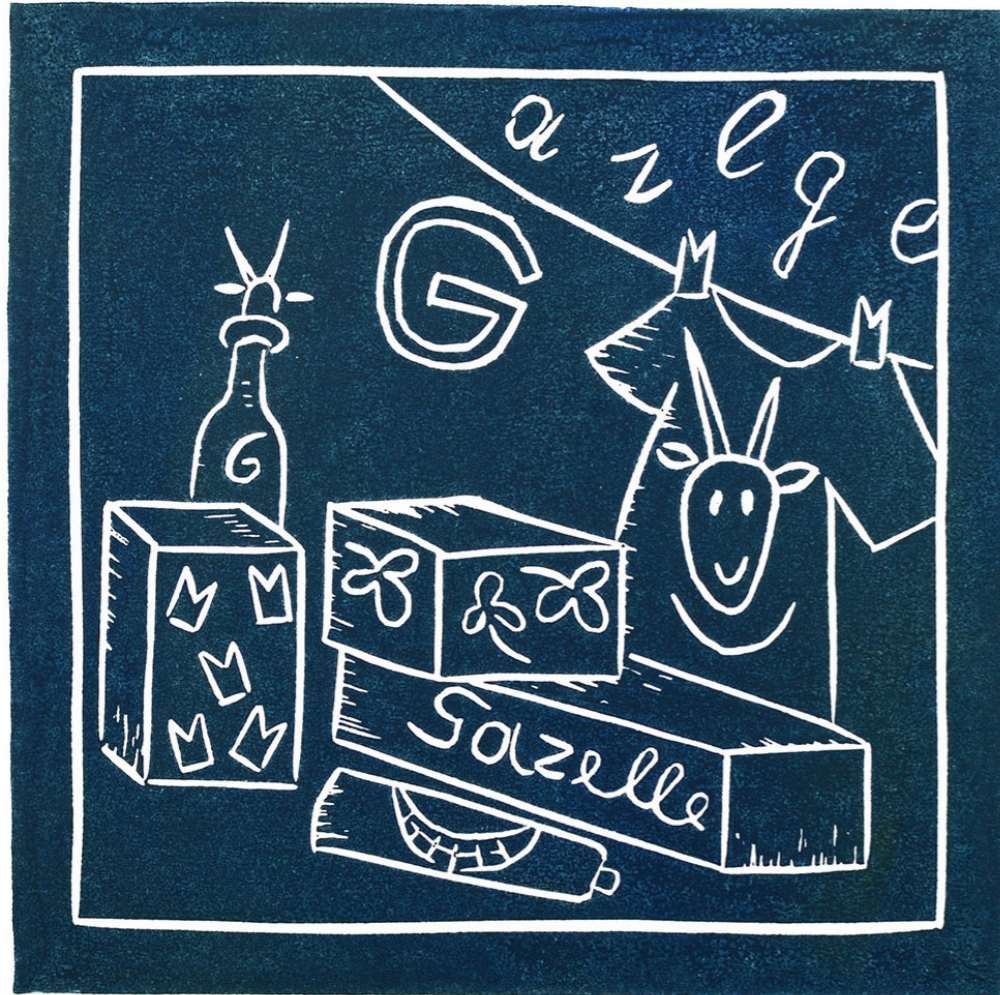


Cows have a pie factory. The pie factory is very mysterious. No one knows what's in the pies but all forest animals eat them.

Gazelles started producing gazelle brand toothpaste, gazelle brand crisps, gazelle everything.



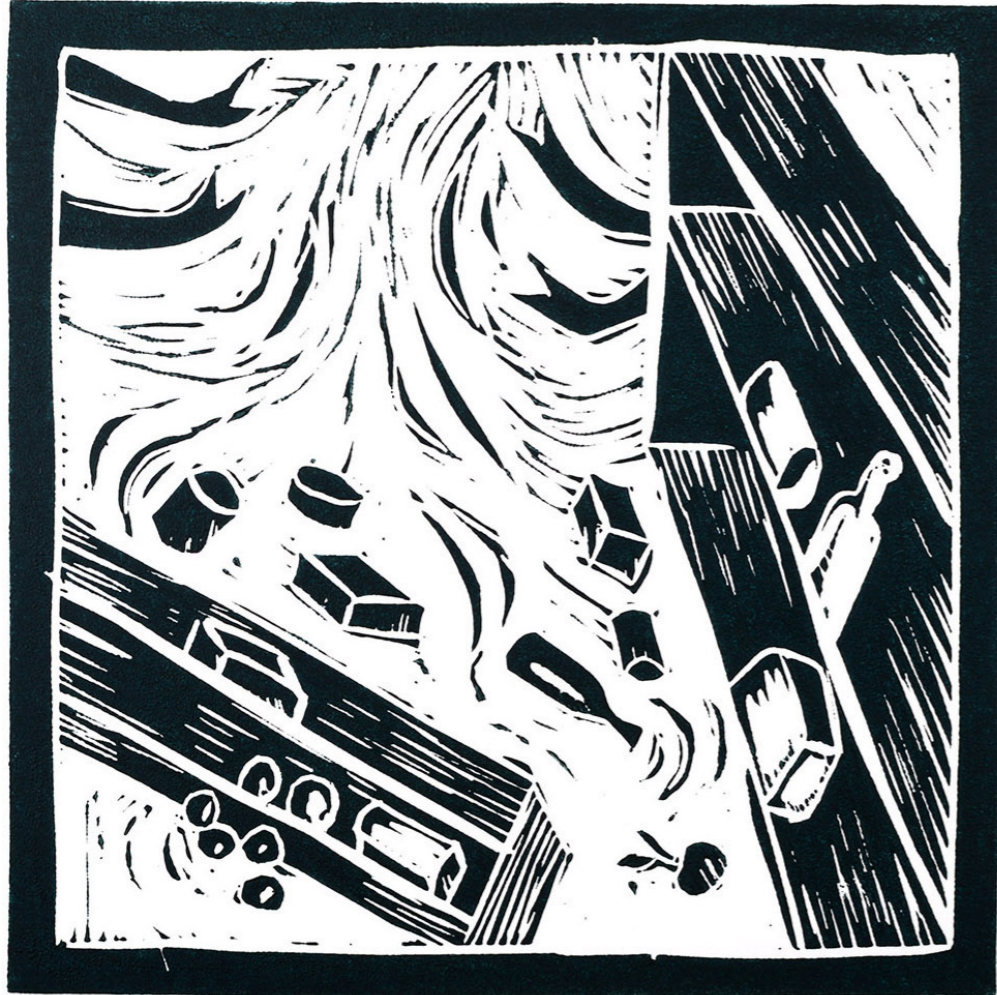
